The 10th Anniversary of the Grand Reopening of The Fox

Spokane's Historical Jewel

The Martin Woldson Theater at The Fox is the premier performance hall of Downtown Spokane. Originally a movie theater, it opened in 1931 to a crowd of 30,000, including movie stars and celebrities, at Spokane's Golden Jubilee. The theater was the largest and most modern in Spokane, but with the rise of suburban cinemas in the 1970s witnessed a gradual decline.

Unwilling to see such a historical treasure demolished, a city-wide effort led by the Spokane Symphony lovingly restored The Fox to its former Art Deco splendor in 2007. It is now home of the seventy piece Symphony which performs for more than 150,000 listeners each season, continuing a long tradition of The Fox as a top performance venue in the Inland Northwest.



10th Anniversary Gala Dinner

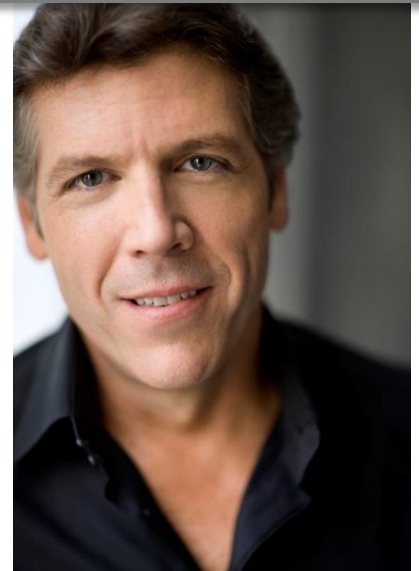
Friday, November 3, 2017 – 6:00pm at The Fox
